POST BACHELOR'S CERTIFICATION PROGRAM IN MUSIC THERAPY
 Music Therapy Equivalency

The equivalency program in music therapy is for individuals who hold a Bachelor's degree in music or fine arts with a music emphasis and who wish to complete coursework necessary for registration and certification as a music therapist without receiving a second Bachelor's degree. Any relevant courses previously earned will be accepted toward completion of the equivalency. All decisions concerning coursework will be made by the Director of Music Therapy. The number of courses required to complete the equivalency program will vary with each individual.

Because an equivalency student will not be pursuing a degree through Arizona State University, private study, ensemble participation or completion of ASU graduation requirements will not be required. An audition is not required for entrance into the program. MUE 211 must be taken in the first semester and the sophomore screening passed before continuing in the program.

Depending on previous background, it is possible to complete this program in three semesters plus the six-month clinical internship. Three semesters in residence at ASU is required
